4.First-aid measures

- Inhalation: : Get medical aid immediately. Remove from exposure to fresh air immediately. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.
- Skin contact: : Immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Remove clothing. Get medical attention immediately. Wash clothing separately before reuse.

5.Fire-fighting measures

Fire Fighting Media and Instructions:

SMALL FIRE: Use DRY chemical powder.

LARGE FIRE: Use carbon dioxide, fog or foam.

UNUSUAL FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARDS:

May burn with an invisible flame. Fire hazard when exposed to heat, flame or oxidizers.

Vapors are heavier than air and may travel a considerable distance to an ignition source and flash back. Vapor mixtures are explosive.

6.Accidental release measures

Stop all leaks. Isolate hazard area. Keep unnecessary and unprotected personnel from entering. Absorb spill with inert material (e.g. dry sand, earth). Eliminate all ignition sources. Prevent runoff from entering drains, sewers, streams or other bodies of water. Absorb unrecoverable product. Transfer contaminated absorbent, soil and other materials to containers for disposal.

7.Handling and storage
